Dr. Nabeel Jabbour is originally from Lebanon. He lived with his family in Egypt for fifteen years. He and his family moved to Colorado Springs in January 1991. Since 1997, the Jabbours have been U.S. citizens.

Although Dr. Jabbour comes from an Arab Christian background, for the first fifty years of his life, Muslims were his neighbors, teachers, friends, roommates, and students. While earning a doctorate in Islamics, Dr. Jabbour's method of study was phenomenology. It is a method of study where the phenomenon is allowed to speak for itself resulting in a compassionate understanding of the phenomenon from the adherent's point of view.

Dr. Jabbour did not want to project his prejudice on Islam and Muslims and come to predetermined conclusions. Instead, he leaned to put on Muslim worldview lenses, to stand in their shoes, and to see the world through their eyes. Today Dr. Jabbour is an adjunct
