- **Listening:** Hearing assistance - LISTEN EVERYWHERE is up and running! Instructions available at the tech booth in the back of the WAC, or at the sanctuary doors. Live broadcast of the service is available in the Chapel Atrium. Audio-only broadcast and additional seating is available in the Plaza or the Ascension Chapel.
- **Nursery:** A nursery is available for newborns to age 4. The nursery is free and staffed by a certified caregiver overseeing volunteers. A preschool lesson is taught by adult volunteers during the service. The Ascension Chapel may be used for a cry room if needed.

**PREPARATION: We confess our common faith**

### The Heidelberg Catechism Q/A #1

**Leader** Christ is spiritually present at this meal - at work through our confession.

Christians, what is your only comfort in life and in death?

**All** *That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ.*

*He has fully paid for all my sins with His precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.*

*Therefore, by his Holy Spirit, He also assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for Him.*

**INSTRUCTION: How we are to come to the Lord's table\***

See 1 Corinthians 11

**INSTITUTION: In the words of Jesus at the Last Supper**

See Matthew 26, Mark 14, and Luke 22

**DISTRIBUTION: We partake in the Lord's Supper**

- We will have four communion stations; the *middle* aisle has *both* regular and gluten-free bread.
- The *outer* ring of cups contains *juice* (light) and the remainder contain *wine* (dark)
- If you have any prayer needs, there are prayer team members standing in the back, available to pray with you.
- All baptized Christians are invited to partake at the Lord's table

*\* Note to Parents: Can my child take communion? We believe that once your child is baptized and you discern they have professed their faith in Christ in an age appropriate way, it is good for them to take communion. Jesus said, "welcome the little children," and so we welcome yours to the Lord's table. If you have any questions about your child's profession of faith, Greg and John would love to meet with you.*

*Do you need to receive communion at your seat? Please raise your hand and our servers will be happy to accommodate your needs.*

*Diaspora Communion is available for all members of CCSF and immediate family who would like to take Communion but are unable to be present at Sunday Worship. The consecrated elements from Sunday will be brought to you at your home, or hospital and a brief Communion Service will take place. ## SERMON REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. Take a moment to consider all that has taken place in Matthew 12 (and perhaps in the entire Gospel of Matthew thus far). How might that help you understand the religious leaders' request for a "sign"? Why do you think that they ask for sign from Jesus?
2. Why do you think Jesus characterizes such a request as the result of participating in "an evil and adulterous [i.e. - covenant breaking] generation"?
3. Jesus says only one sign will be given - the "sign of Jonah." What is this sign exactly? Jonah's commission to go to the enemies of God's people? His preaching in Nineveh? His going down into the belly of the fish?
4. Jesus refers to two stories from the Bible to bolster his statement that only one sign will be given. What point is making with those stories?
5. How do we have "something greater" in the person of Jesus? In what way can we say that He is, Himself, the full revelation of God for us?
6. Spend some time praising God for giving us His Son Jesus Christ.
