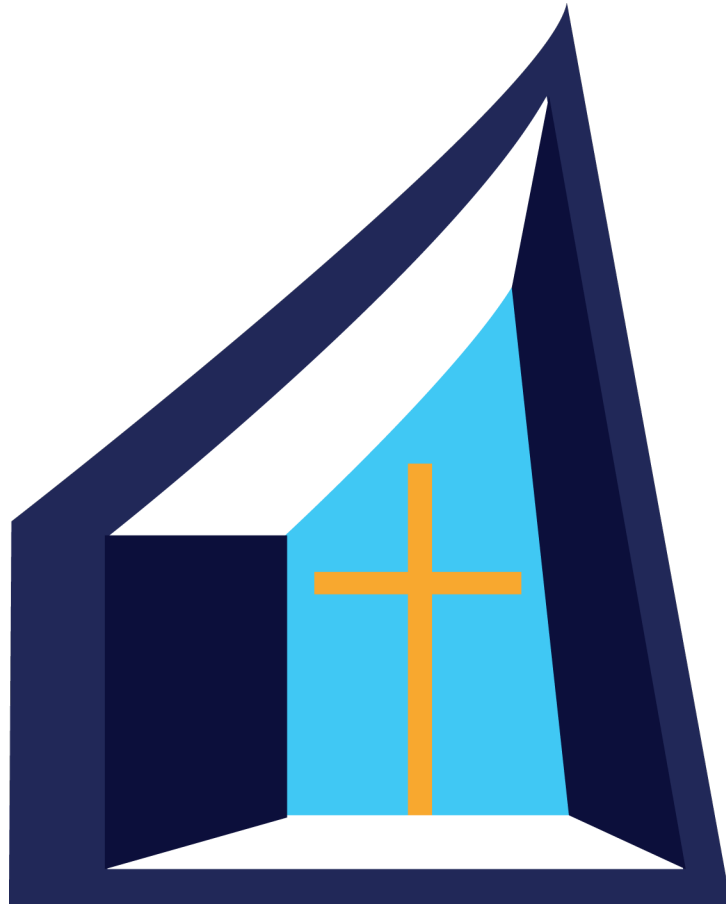

## ✦ HOLY SCRIPTURE

### Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43

24 [Jesus] put another parable before them, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field, 25 but while his men were sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat and went away. 26 So when the plants came up and bore grain, then the weeds appeared also. 27 And the servants of the master of the house came and said to him, 'Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have weeds?' 28 He said to them, 'An enemy has done this.' So the servants said to him, 'Then do you want us to go and gather them?' 29 But he said, 'No, lest in gathering the weeds you root up the wheat along with them. 30 Let both grow together until the harvest, and at harvest time I will tell the reapers, "Gather the weeds first and bind them in bundles to be burned, but gather the wheat into my barn."'"

36 Then he left the crowds and went into the house. And his disciples came to him, saying, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds of the field." 37 He answered, "The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. 38 The field is the world, and the good seed is the sons of the kingdom. The weeds are the sons of the evil one, 39 and the enemy who sowed them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are angels. 40 Just as the weeds are gathered and burned with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. 41 The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will gather out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all law-breakers, 42 and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. 43 Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear.

## THE LORD'S SUPPER

**PREPARATION: We confess our common faith**

**The Westminster Shorter Catechism, Q & A 36**

**Leader:** Christ is spiritually present at this meal - at work through our confession.

**INSTITUTION: In the words of Jesus at the Last Supper**

**DISTRIBUTION: We partake in the Lord's Supper**

- We will have four communion stations; the *middle* aisle has *both* regular and gluten-free bread.
- The *outer* ring of cups contains *juice* (light) and the remainder contain *wine* (dark)
- If you have any prayer needs, there are prayer team members standing in the back, available to pray with you.
- All baptized Christians are invited to partake at the Lord's table

*\* Note to Parents: Can my child take communion? We believe that once your child is baptized and you discern they have professed their faith in Christ in an age appropriate way, it is good for them to take communion. Jesus said, "welcome the little children," and so we welcome yours to the Lord's table. If you have any questions about your child's profession of faith, Greg and John would love to meet with you.*

*Do you need to receive communion at your seat? Please raise your hand and our servers will be happy to accommodate your needs.*

*Diaspora Communion is available for all members of CCSF and immediate family who would like to take Communion but are unable to be present at Sunday Worship. The consecrated elements from Sunday will be brought to you at your home, or hospital and a brief Communion Service will take place. 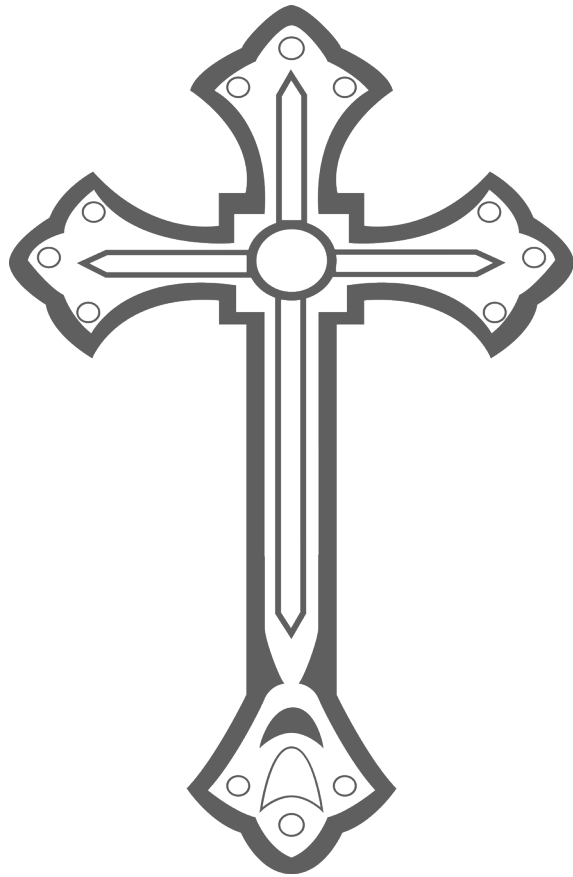
## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What clue do we have about the importance of this parable in the first part of v. 24? What comparison does Jesus make in this verse?
2. A lot happens in vv. 25-28. Can you sum it up in terms of what happens and how people react? How might this shape your view of how we can understand God's activity in the world?
3. Read vv. 28-29. What did the servants volunteer to do for the owner? On what grounds did the owner turn down their offer? What did he propose instead? Again, how might this shape your view of how we understand God's activity in the world?
4. Who approached Jesus for further explanation? (v. 36) How does Jesus explain the parable? Can you sum up who the owner represents? The field? The "good seed" and the "weeds"? The harvesters?
5. What future event does the harvest represent? (v. 39) What is the significance of the burning of the weeds?
6. What is the future for the righteous? What strikes you about how they are described?
7. Why do you think Jesus concludes his explanation by saying, "He who has ears, let him hear?" What do we need to really hear Jesus? How can that help you pray? Serve? Love your neighbors? Endure difficulty or confusion?
