Instructions available at the tech booth in the back of the WAC, or at the sanctuary doors. <u>Live broadcast</u> of the service is available in the Chapel Atrium. <u>Audio-only broadcast</u> and additional seating is available in the Plaza or the Ascension Chapel.
- Nursery: A nursery is available for newborns to age 4. The nursery is free and staffed by a certified caregiver overseeing volunteers. A preschool lesson is taught by adult volunteers during the service. The Ascension Chapel may be used for a cry room if needed.

SERMON REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- 1. What are some things that make you anxious? Why do you think that's the case? What triggers the feelings? What's at the root? I would encourage you to share some specifics with your group and be as vulnerable as you're able.
- **2**. How does Jesus' teaching on anxiety, which points us to the care and concern of God, help us to combat the negative of affects of being anxious.
- **3.** What does Jesus' teaching on the law show us about the love and heart of our God toward us in our fears and struggles to trust?
- **4**. Because the law always has a positive (do), in light of the negative (do no), what does Jesus encourage his disciples to replace anxiety with? As we do that in the power of the gospel, how does it actually serve to help us with our anxiousness?
