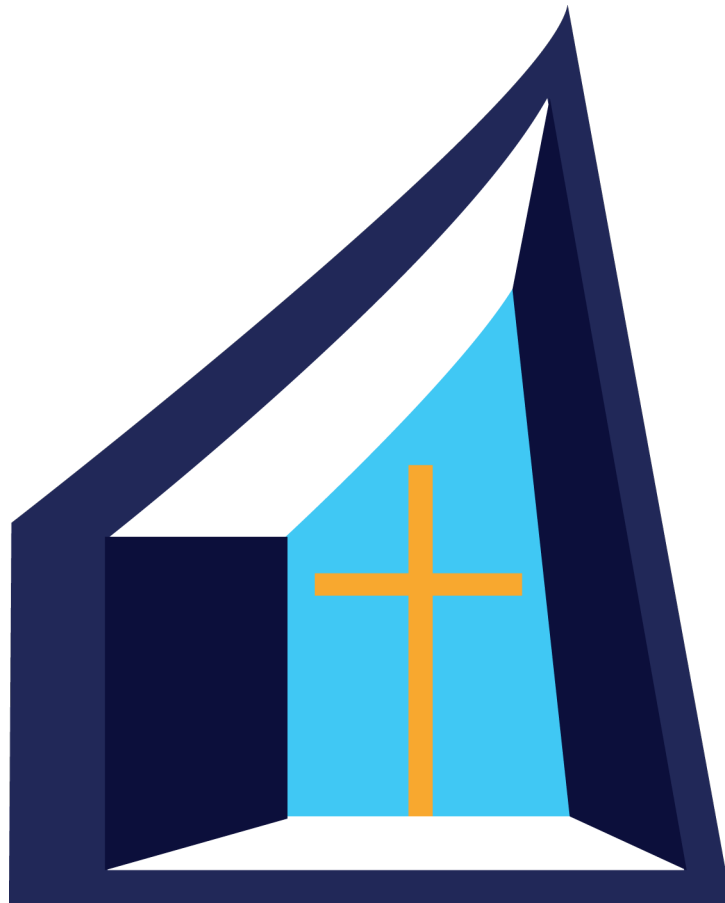

- **Welcome! We're glad you're here!** Whether you're investigating the Christian faith, looking for a church home, or have been with us for a long time, all are welcome. We are a church that loves this city of Santa Fe and are grateful for the Gospel (Good News) of Jesus and His mercy toward imperfect people like us. The love of God be with you all!.
- **First time visitors:** Stop at the front desk to pick up a special gift!
- **Worship space:** We ask that you please **enter the Sanctuary quietly** as our worship provides a time of peaceful reflection for all. **Please silence** your cell phones.
- **Listening:** Hearing assistance - LISTEN EVERYWHERE is up and running! Instructions available at the tech booth in the back of the WAC, or at the sanctuary doors. Live broadcast of the service is available in the Chapel Atrium. Audio-only broadcast and additional seating is available in the Plaza or the Ascension Chapel.
- **Nursery:** A nursery is available for newborns to age 4. The nursery is free and staffed by a certified caregiver overseeing volunteers. A preschool lesson is taught by adult volunteers during the service. The Ascension Chapel may be used for a cry room if needed.

Call to Confession

(Please kneel or bow your head)

Leader: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

*(Pause for silent confession of our sins)**

Prayer of Confession

All: *Almighty and merciful God, we have erred and strayed from Your ways like lost sheep. We have followed too much the devices and desires of our own hearts. We have offended against Your holy laws. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done; and we have done those things which we ought not to have done. O LORD, have mercy upon us. Spare those who confess their faults. Restore those who are penitent, according to your promises declared to the world in Christ Jesus, our Lord. And grant, O merciful God, for His sake, that we may live a holy, just, and humble life to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.*

Assurance of Pardon

(Please stand)

Leader: There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. To those who repent and look to Jesus Christ for their salvation, the absolution of sins is effected in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

PASTORAL PRAYER

THE LORD'S SUPPER

PREPARATION: We confess our common faith

The Heidelberg Catechism, Q/A !8 & 19

Leader Christ is spiritually present at this meal - at work through our confession.

But who is that Mediator, who is at the same time true God and a true, sinless man?

All *Our Lord Jesus Christ, who is freely given unto us for complete redemption and righteousness.*

Leader From where do you know this?

All *From the Holy Gospel, which God Himself first revealed in Paradise; afterwards proclaimed by the holy Patriarchs and Prophets, and foreshadowed by the sacrifices and other ceremonies of the Law; and finally fulfilled by His well-beloved Son.*

INSTRUCTION: How we are to come to the Lord's table*

See 1 Corinthians 11

INSTITUTION: In the words of Jesus at the Last Supper

See Matthew 26, Mark 14, and Luke 22

DISTRIBUTION: We partake in the Lord's Supper

- We will have four communion stations; the *middle* aisle has *both* regular and gluten-free bread.
- The *outer* ring of cups contains *juice* (light) and the remainder contain *wine* (dark)
- If you have any prayer needs, there are prayer team members standing in the back, available to pray with you.
- All baptized Christians are invited to partake at the Lord's table

** Note to Parents: Can my child take communion? We believe that once your child is baptized and you discern they have professed their faith in Christ in an age appropriate way, it is good for them to take communion. Jesus said, "welcome the little children," and so we welcome yours to the Lord's table. If you have any questions about your child's profession of faith, Greg and John would love to meet with you.*

Do you need to receive communion at your seat? Please raise your hand and our servers will be happy to accommodate your needs.

Diaspora Communion is available for all members of CCSF and immediate family who would like to take Communion but are unable to be present at Sunday Worship. The consecrated elements from Sunday will be brought to you at your home, or hospital and a brief Communion Service will take place. SERMON REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. What is differentiates the miracle in v. 32 from the other miracles in Matt. 8 and 9? Why might this be important?
2. Vv. 33 and 34 describe a division between the people and the religious leaders. How does Matthew's description of this division prompt the reader to make a decision for themselves about Jesus?
3. Take some time with v. 35. What is Jesus doing? How is He doing it? How might this inform the mission and method of Jesus followers?
4. What's notable about Jesus' posture toward the world in v. 36? How do you look out on those who have yet to receive Jesus? How does the heart of Jesus toward the lost shape your own perspective?
5. How does Jesus describe the mission field in v. 37? What is remarkable about it in terms of what it is and what is needed?
6. Looking at v. 38, what is fundamental to the work of mission? [NB: the word for "ask" in some translations is "pray"] Why should prayer be central to the life and mission of the Church?
7. Take some time to pray as Jesus asks us in this passage, that workers would be sent out into the harvest.
