- **3**. What were some of the major social sin abuses in Roman culture, for both women and men? How do we see these in our own day? In our own hearts?
- **4.** Where is Jesus, through Peter, calling his children to trust him in this text? Why is that often difficult? What is the glory promised in the trusting?
- **5**. What are some of the specific ways Peter calls Wives and Husbands to serve one another? How do these mortify (put to death) sin, promote trust, and shine Jesus' light to the world.
