- **Listening:** <u>Hearing assistance</u> LISTEN EVERYWHERE is up and running! Instructions available at the tech booth in the back of the WAC, or at the sanctuary doors. <u>Live broadcast</u> of the service is available in the Chapel Atrium. <u>Audio-only broadcast</u> and additional seating is available in the Plaza or the Ascension Chapel.
- Nursery: A nursery is available for newborns to age 4. The nursery is free and staffed by a certified caregiver overseeing volunteers. A preschool lesson is taught by adult volunteers during the service. The Ascension Chapel may be used for a cry room if needed.

SERMON REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- 1. On what basis, and for what reason, does Peter implore his hearers to arm themselves in verse 1? How does this ground of motive make the difference?
- **2.** Why would elect exiles, like us, need to arm themselves in the first place? What's the nature of the spiritual war? What other scriptures might help us here? How does that inform our mission?
- **3**. In verses 2 and 3, Peter writes to those with a past, concerning the hope of a future. How have you seen God be faithful to you in your past, to rescue and redeem?
- **4.** What does Peter say we should do above all? (verse 8) Why? How does He spell out what this looks like in verses 9-11? How can we apply that?
- **5.** In verse 11 Peter gives us the big purpose (in order that) for suffering in and with Christ in wisdom and love. How does that give us confidence and security in an ever changing world?
